## **Reported Problems**

### **Gage County**

Shortly after early ballots were sent out, it was discovered that the Nebraska Public Power District Subdivision Eight was left off of the ballots. At that time 456 early voting ballots had been mailed. The County Clerk mailed a supplemental ballot containing the NPPD race along with a postage supplied envelope. Of the 456 supplemental ballots, 419 were returned and counted. Polling place ballots were not impacted as the necessary correction had been made. The margin in the race was 4083 votes so the outcome of the election was not impacted.

### **Furnas County**

The County Clerk misread or misinterpreted the Lower Republican NRD certification and provided all voters in Furnas County both Lower Republican NRD Subdistrict 1 and Subdistrict 2 ballots. The error was discovered after the original certification to the Secretary of State. The County Clerk submitted a supplemental certification removing the improper votes from each race total. The Subdistrict 2 race was uncontested (only 1 candidate) so the error did not impact the outcome of the race. Although the Subdistrict 1 race was contested, the error did not change the outcome.
