● **PROBLEMS IDENTIFIED BY LOCAL OFFICIALS**

**1996 GENERAL ELECTION**

● **Saunders County/Lower Platte South NRD**

One precinct (Ceresco) had Lower Platte North NRD on Ballot rather than Lower Platte South. Problem was discovered at 8:45 AM when 29 voters had been through the polls. Ballots were printed and delivered to the polling place by 9:30 AM. Between 8:45 and 9:30 AM, voters 30 through 79 were informed about the error and informed they could return later to vote the NRD ballot. Voters 1 through 29 were all contacted either in person or by message that they could return to the polling place to vote the ballot. Twelve of the 79 affected did return to cast ballots. In addition, 18 improper absentee ballots were issued. Of the absentee ballots 5 were returned after the deadline.

● **Buffalo County/Central Platte NRD**

Races (Subs 1-7,9) were left off of ballots in City of Kearney. Only Subdistricts 7 and 9 were contested. Problem was discovered at approximately 1:00 PM. Paper ballots were made and delivered to the 17 precincts involved by approximately 2:00 PM. Those who did not receive ballot total 4, 174. Commissioner contacted area media to inform public of problem and allow voters to return to vote NRD ballot if desired. It is not known how many returned to cast ballot. Other information:

● Total ballots issued: 5035

Votes cast in either sub 7 or 9 (but not other): 70

Votes cast in both sub 7 and 9: 3372

Votes cast for other NRD races but not 7 or 9: 456

Ballot received but no vote cast in any NRD sub: 1137

● **Custer County/Lower Loup NRD**

Subdistricts 1, 5, and 6 were included on the ballot when it should have been Subdistricts 1, 2, and 3. Subs 2 and 3 were uncontested, so no impact on outcome.

● **Hitchcock County/Southwest Public Power**

In Subdistrict 1, there should have been two races, one for a full 6 year term and one to complete another term (4 yrs.) In one township (Stratton), both names were placed on the ballot as competing for the 4 year term. There were approximately 262 ballots issued. As both terms were uncontested, no impact on outcome.

● **Banner County/Chimney Rock Public Power**

Five eligible voters, ballots were not available.

● **Lincoln County/Dawson Public Power**

Poll workers failed to issue ballots for two races (one six year and one 4 year term). Poll workers discovered ballots in their supplies after polls closed. Both races unopposed so no impact on outcome.

### PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 1

A vote "FOR" this proposal will allow the Legislature to authorize off-track pari-mutuel betting on horseraces by such means and at such locations as it might determine, thus removing the present requirement that all betting on horseraces be conducted by licensees within licensed racetrack enclosures in the state.

A vote "AGAINST" this proposal will retain the present requirement that all pari-mutuel betting on horseraces be conducted by licensees within licensed racetrack enclosures.

A constitutional amendment to remove the restriction that wagering on the results of horseraces by the parimutuel method be conducted within a licensed racetrack enclosure and to authorize such wagering to be conducted at locations and by means authorized by the Legislature.

### PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 2

A vote "FOR" this proposal: (a) will provide for the merger or consolidation of counties or other local governments such as municipalities with the approval of a majority of the people in each county or municipality to be merged or consolidated; (b) will allow such merger or consolidation to be initiated by petition; (c) will allow the Legislature to provide for differences in tax rates within and outside municipalities and on different classes of property so long as the differences in tax rates and classifications are reasonable and are required by an agreement between local governments, governing such mergers or consolidations; (d) would change the allocation of proceeds from the motor vehicle tax; (e) would exempt from taxation property of the state and its governmental subdivisions to the extent that it is used for a public purpose, and to the extent such property is not used for a public purpose, will allow the Legislature to classify it, exempt it, tax it, or provide for payments in lieu of property taxes; and (f) repeal provisions in the constitution relating to towns and township organizations.

A vote "AGAINST" this proposal will deny the Legislature the power to provide for the merger or consolidation of counties and municipalities or other local governments under the procedures and conditions outlined above, or to provide for the undertaking of other activities set forth above relating to tax rates, the allocation of motor vehicle taxes, the exemption or not of public property, and the repeal of those provisions relating to towns or townships.

A constitutional amendment to authorize legislation relating to mergers and consolidations by local governments, to authorize the Legislature to provide for differences in tax rates within and outside municipalities, to change a restriction on allocation of proceeds from motor vehicle taxes, to provide that property of the state and its governmental subdivisions is exempt from taxation to the extent such property is used for public purposes and to authorize classification and taxation of such property, and to repeal and eliminate provisions dealing with township organization and towns.

A vote “**FOR**” will amend the Constitution of Nebraska by adding a new provision which would instruct Nebraska’s members of Congress and state legislators to support passage and ratification of an amendment to the U.S. Constitution limiting U.S. Representatives to three terms and Senators to two terms; inform voters of candidates’ position on these term limits; and instruct the Nebraska legislature to apply to Congress to convene an Article V Convention to propose an amendment to the U.S. Constitution to limit Congressional terms.

A vote “**AGAINST**” will not cause the Constitution of Nebraska to be amended in such a manner.

Shall the Nebraska Constitution be amended to: instruct Nebraska’s members of Congress and state legislators to support passage and ratification of an amendment to the U.S. Constitution limiting U.S. Representatives to three terms and Senators to two terms; inform voters of the position of candidates for Congress and legislature on the specified congressional term limits by placing language on election ballots; and instruct state legislators to apply to Congress to convene an Article V Convention for the propose of proposing an amendment to the U.S. Constitution to limit congressional terms? (Provisions severable).

**PROPOSED BY INITIATIVE PETITION MEASURE 410**

A vote “**FOR**” will amend the Constitution of Nebraska to return the number of signatures required on initiative and referendum petitions to ten percent of the votes cast for Governor at the most recent preceding general election if for a proposed Constitutional amendment; seven percent of such votes cast if for enactment of a law; ten percent of such votes cast if seeking to suspend the effect of an act of the Legislature pending a vote of the people; and five percent of such votes cast if for a referendum on an act of the Legislature.

A vote “**AGAINST**” will not cause the Constitution of Nebraska to be amended in such a manner and the number of signatures required will be based on percentages of the total number of registered voters.

Shall the Nebraska Constitution be amended to provide that: petitions seeking to place proposed measures on the ballot for a vote of the people be signed by registered voters equaling ten percent of the votes cast for Governor at the most recent preceding general election if for a proposed Constitutional amendment; seven percent if for enactment of a law; ten percent of such votes cast if seeking to suspend the effect of an act of the Legislature pending a vote of the people; and five percent of such votes cast if for a referendum on an act of the Legislature?
